What's New

Chiquita Canyon Landfill (CCL) held a "free disposal day" on Saturday, March 2, 2019, for residents of Val Verde and Castaic. The next upcoming free disposal day is June 8, 2019. Each resident is allowed up to one-ton of disposal free of charge.

Regulatory and Permitting Activities

During the 1st Quarter of 2019 (Q1; January through March), CCL continued coordination with regulatory agencies in support of necessary permits for Cell 6 construction:

- Grading/Drainage Permit for review by Los Angeles County Department of Public Works
- Cell 6 Liner Construction Permit for review by the Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board
- Water Quality Certification under Section 401 of the Clean Water Act for review by the Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board (RWQCB)

During Q1, CCL received the following permits for Cell 6 construction:

- Nationwide Permit 18 under Section 404 of the Clean Water Act by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers
- Streambed Alteration Agreement under Section 1602 of the California Fish and Game Code by the California Department of Fish and Wildlife

Also, during Q1, CCL was granted a short-term tonnage increase of 20% by the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors to receive fire debris from the Woolsey Fire. To date, CCL has not received any fire debris and has not increased inbound waste tons.
