What's New

Chiquita Canyon Landfill (CCL) held a "free disposal day" on Saturday, June 1, 2019, for residents of Val Verde and Castaic. The next upcoming free disposal day is Saturday, September 7, 2019. Each resident is allowed up to one-ton of disposal free of charge.

CCL is currently constructing Cell 6, which will be used for waste disposal beginning in late 2019.

The Community Advisory Committee (CAC) has been established by the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors. The first meeting of the CAC will be held on October 15th.

Regulatory and Permitting Activities

During the 2nd Quarter of 2019 (Q2; April through June), CCL continued coordination with regulatory agencies in support of necessary permits for ongoing expansion activities:

- Submitted applications for Streambed Alteration Agreements under Section 1602 of the California Fish and Game Code to the California Department of Fish and Wildlife for Cell 8 construction and construction of new entrance facilities
- Submitted application for Water Quality Certification under Section 401 of the Clean Water Act to the Regional Water Quality Control Board for Cell 8 construction
- Submitted application for Individual Permit under Section 404 of the Clean Water Act to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers for Cell 8 construction

During Q2, CCL received the following permits or approvals for Cell 6 construction:

- Grading/Drainage Permit for Cell 6 construction by Los Angeles County Department of Public Works
- Waiver of Water Quality Certification under Section 401 of the Clean Water Act by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers for Cell 6 construction
- Nationwide Permit 18 under Section 404 of the Clean Water Act by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers for Cell 6 construction

Streambed Alteration Agreement under Section 1602 of the California Fish and Game Code by the California Department of Fish and Wildlife for Cell 6 construction
