Purpose of This Meeting

Pursuant to the Stipulated Order for Abatement, Chiquita Canyon will host a public one-hour community meeting once a month. During each meeting, Chiquita Canyon will provide updates with regards to implementation of the Order and make time available for public comment on matters related to the Landfill. The meeting date, time and format (in-person or virtual) will be announced via Chiquita's website and will also be sent via email to everyone who has signed up for email notifications on Chiquita's website. The announcement will include a link and dial-in information to the virtual platform used to conduct the meeting, or if the meeting is in-person, the location of the meeting. All meetings held in person will adhere to all applicable public health guidelines and will take place within the Val Verde community.

Stipulated Order (Background)

- During July, August, and September 2020, Chiquita received NOVs from the South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD).
- SCAQMD and Chiquita worked together to reach an agreement on how to address potential odors in the form of a Stipulated Order for Abatement.
- On December 16, 2020, the SCAQMD Hearing Board approved the Stipulated Order.

Modified Stipulated Order (Background)

- Since the December 2020 hearing, Chiquita received 0 NOVs from the SCAQMD.
- The December 2020 Stipulated Order required that Chiquita retain a consultant to assess landfill operations and meteorological conditions.
- Two consultants jointly prepared a report documenting their analysis, including recommendations on landfill operational improvements and continued analyses of wind data. That report is available on Chiquita's website.
- SCAQMD and Chiquita worked together to incorporate each of the consultants' recommendations into a modified Stipulated Order for Abatement.
- On March 24, 2021, the SCAQMD Hearing Board approved the modified Stipulated Order.

Community Outreach and Community Odor Surveillance

- Hosting these community meetings once per month
 - Meeting materials will be posted to the website
- Created and are maintaining a dedicated section of our website for information related to the modified Stipulated Order
- Conducting odor surveillance around the Chiquita Canyon Landfill

Modified Stipulated Order – Community Odor Surveillance

- **Condition 1(a)** – Chiquita must hire a consultant to provide training on odor surveillance practices.
 - Consultant must conduct initial training and quarterly refresher training.
 - Consultant must accompany Chiquita on odor surveillance trips for additional instruction for three weeks.
 - Chiquita must document all training.
- **Condition 1(b)** – Chiquita must conduct community odor surveillance twice daily.
- **Condition 1(d)** – Lists 20 locations where Chiquita must conduct each odor surveillance
- **Condition 1(g)** – Chiquita logs the results of these odor surveillances.
 - These logs are posted on Chiquita’s website.
- **Condition 1(h)** – Odor surveillance data may impact whether Chiquita may place waste in Cell 6.

Modified Stipulated Order – Working Face and Disposal Locations

- The modified Stipulated Order requires a reduction in the size of the working face and dictates the size of the working face and working face locations based on wind data and odor surveillance data.
 - Condition 4 limits the size of the working face during the best conditions.
 - Condition 3 limits the size of the working face and dictates working face locations based on wind data.
- Each of these requirements will be replaced by new written Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs – more on these later) pursuant to Condition 25 of the modified Stipulated Order.

Modified Stipulated Order – Cover and Odor Neutralization

- Intermediate cover
- Tarps as daily cover
- New alternative daily cover (Enviro-Cover)
 - Obtained approval
 - Enviro-Cover machine is currently onsite and in use
- Tier 4 engines for orchard fans
 - Application submitted; awaiting approval
 - Currently using other fans while we await approval for these larger fans

Modified Stipulated Order – Consultants

- Maintain and improve landfill gas collection system
 - Retained consultant
 - Monthly logs can be found on Chiquita's website
- Assess prevailing wind patterns in Cells 7 and 9-13
- Evaluate changes in wind dynamics from development of Cells 6 and 8
- Study air movement along western perimeter of landfill (near Cells 6 and 8), including assessment of feasibility of vegetative barrier or other air flow disruptor

Modified Stipulated Order – Odor Control Supervisor

- Retained Odor Control Supervisor
 - Profiling odorous loads (with consultant assistance)
 - Developing (with consultant assistance) and will implement Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs)
 - Designated an Odor Control Zone (OC Zone)
 - Developing Key Performance Indicators (KPIs) to assess progress

Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs)

- Odorous loads – detection, prohibition, diversion, and recordkeeping
- Cell development at OC Zone and Cell 6

Modified Stipulated Order – Litter Fence

- Constructing a litter fence to serve as an air flow disruptor at the western ridge of the landfill, including along both saddles (low points) in the ridgeline

Public Comment/Questions
